

Smoking prohibition

The Royal Decree of 13 December 2005 prohibits smoking in public places with effect from 1 January 2006.

The expression 'public places' means places which are accessible for the public.

This Royal Decree entered into force on 1 January 2006 and operates together with the Royal Decree of 19 January 2005 which must ensure that employees are protected against tobacco smoke.

In Kortrijk Xpo, it is possible to smoke outside the buildings.

There are ashtrays by every entrance so that you can smoke outside or put out your cigarette as you enter.

Visitors are reminded that there is a complete smoking prohibition in force inside and outside the buildings.

With effect from 1 January 2007, there will be a general smoking prohibition in catering establishments.
